This letter is in response to Crossfield Products Corporation's request for extension of qualification approval of "DEX-O-TEX A-70 LATEX CONCRETE VLW" (currently qualified under MIL-D-21631A(1) NOT 3, "Deck Covering, Latex Concrete") to type VI, class 1, grade A, composition O under MIL-PRF-32584, "Deck Covering Materials, Monolithic."

Based on the satisfactory test data documented in the above reports, and the certification that the formulation of the subject product has not changed from that which was qualified under MIL-D-21631A(1) NOT 3, "DEX-O-TEX A-70 LATEX CONCRETE VLW" meets the requirements of MIL-PRF-32584 type VI, class 1, grade A, composition O. Qualification is hereby extended to "DEX-O-TEX A-70 LATEX CONCRETE VLW" as type VI, class 1, grade A, composition O, under MIL-PRF-32584.
